LAKE LIVINGSTON HYDRO-ELECTRIC PROJECT FERC Project No. 12632 PUBLIC SCOPING MEETING AND SITE VISIT

Take notice that on March 26, 2008, a public scoping meeting and site visit will be conducted in Livingston, Texas, in connection with a proposal by the East Texas Electric Cooperative, Inc. (ETEC) to develop hydroelectric generating facilities at Lake Livingston Dam. On December 21, 2007, ETEC notified the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) that it intends to apply for a license under the Federal Power Act to construct and operate hydroelectric facilities at Lake Livingston. The public scoping meeting and site visit are the first steps in a process that will lead to FERC's preparation of an Environmental Assessment (EA) of the proposed action under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

The purposes of the scoping meeting are to:

1. Initiate scoping of issues pursuant to NEPA by inviting participation of federal, state and local resource agencies, Native American tribes, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), and the public to identify significant environmental and socioeconomic issues related to the proposed project;

2. Determine the resource areas, depth of analysis, and significance of issues to be addressed in the EA;

3. Review and discuss existing conditions and resource management objectives;

4. Review and discuss existing information and identify preliminary information and study needs;

5. Review, discuss, and finalize the process plan and schedule for pre-filing activity, while maximizing, to the extent reasonably possible, coordination of federal and state permitting and certification processes, including consultation under section 7 of the Endangered Species Act (if applicable) and water quality certification under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act; and

6. Discuss the appropriateness of any Federal or State agency or Indian tribe acting as a cooperating agency for development of an environmental document pursuant to the NEPA.

Scoping Meeting – Time and Location: The scoping meeting will be held in the Community Meeting Room at the Livingston-Polk County Chamber of Commerce, 1001 US Hwy 59 Loop North, Livingston, Texas. The scoping meeting will

be conducted in two sessions on Wednesday, March 26, 2008: an afternoon session from 1:30 to 3:30 p.m.; and an evening session from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. The dual sessions are designed to accommodate individuals whose schedules permit them to attend only in the afternoon or in the evening. Any individual may attend either or both sessions.

Site Visit – Time, Location and Registration: The site visit to Lake Livingston Dam will take place at the Trinity River Authority of Texas's Lake Livingston project headquarters following the afternoon session of the scoping meeting, at approximately 3:45 p.m. The physical address of the project is 5170 S. FM 1988, Livingston, Texas, 77351. Access to the dam site is secure, and all individuals wishing to participate in the site visit must register and provide a copy of a photo identification in advance.
